Cabins & Bathrooms

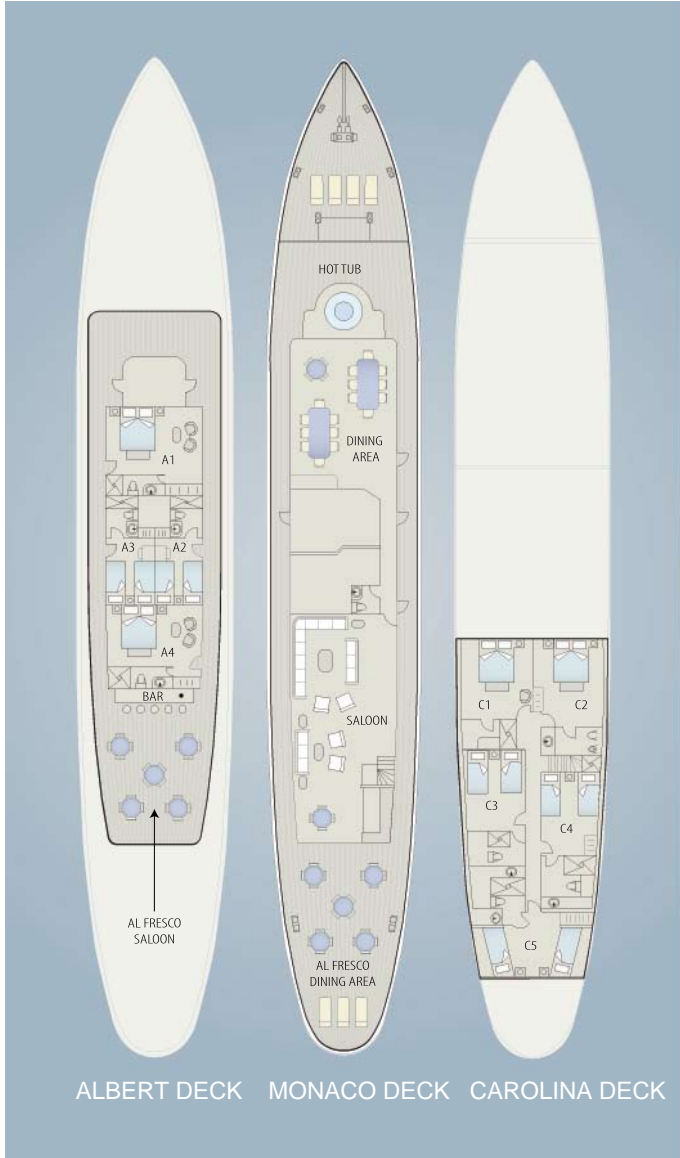

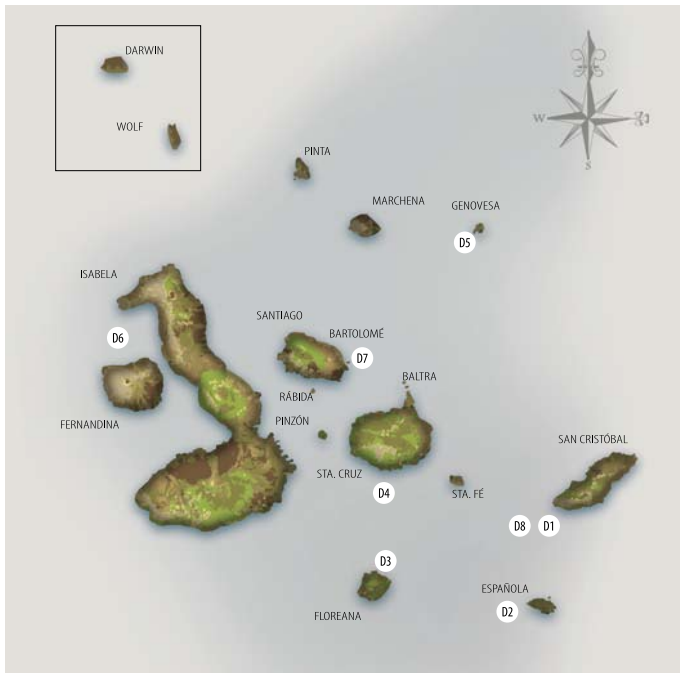
