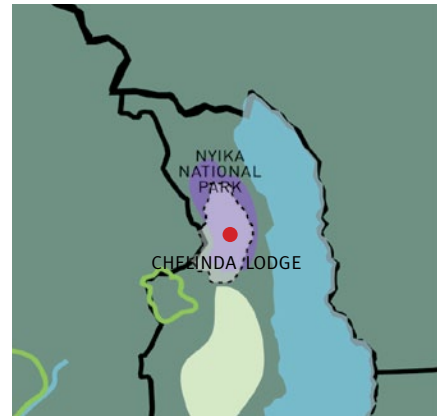


NYIKA NATIONAL PARK

Classic Wilderness Camp



Chelinda Lodge (opening July 2010) offers spacious log cabins all with sweeping views over Nyika's rolling grasslands, which are often dotted with large herds of roan, eland and zebra. A pocket of hagenia woodland and forest backdrop perfectly shelters this idyllic upland camp. Accommodation comprises 8 warm log cabins made of pine with fireplace, en-suite bathroom and an upstairs viewing area or room for accompanying children. Two chalets are joined to form an interconnected family unit. Elevated wooden walkways link the cabins to the inviting main building complete with outside deck for sundowners, convivial dining around a fireplace and lounge area for quiet reflection or conversation.



Activities include nature drives to discover the wonders of the Park, informative walks, birding, fly-fishing for trout from a network of lakes (most close to the lodge), mountain biking and horse riding. Visiting Chelinda Lodge is an exciting component to any visit to Malawi and indeed to the subregion.
