

# SERRA CAFEMA CAMP

## KUNENE - MARIENFLUSS CONSERVANCY

Premier Wilderness Camp



Set amongst shady trees on the banks of the Kunene River, Serra Cafema is one of the most remote camps in southern Africa, its Portuguese name hailing from the mountains that dominate the northern skyline. Guests fall asleep to the sound of rushing water, while by day they explore one of the driest deserts in the world.

The camp's eight unique canvas and thatched chalets, each with its own en-suite bathroom have attention to detail; the elevated decks and simple structures create a camp that is at one with its surroundings. The dining room, bar and pool look out over the Kunene River. Activities here are varied, including boating (seasonal), walking, birding, viewing breathtaking landscapes, as well as carefully guided quad-bike excursions and game drives that tread lightly on the dunes. In this isolated region, the Himba people continue their nomadic traditional way of life, and when in the area, offer guests the opportunity to learn about their lifestyle and traditions.
