The three-night, four-day Pafuri Walking Trail takes place in the 24 000ha Makuleke Concession. The area is blessed with abundant game, spectacular scenery, a sense of history and a true feeling of wilderness and remoteness as well as an authentic community partnership. There is no better way to explore this magnificent area than on foot.

This trail is led by an experienced armed guide and tracker. Accommodation is in four walk-in dome tents ensuring that guests are intimately connected with the surrounding wilderness. The site of the camp is different each night, with trailists walking from one location to the next with the freedom to explore or to adjust routes dependent on local conditions. In this way, guests have the opportunity to experience first-hand the astounding diversity of Pafuri: a blend of habitat, scenery and associated wildlife and bird life that makes the area unique.
