

VICTORIA FALLS  
Classic Wilderness Camp



The River Club overlooks the Zambezi River, 18km upstream from Victoria Falls. Its main area is a well-appointed Edwardian house with lounge, dining room, library, shop and veranda on which breakfasts and teas are taken. Midday meals are often served on manicured lawns complete with croquet lawn. The gazebo and the Summer House (with snooker room) are both alternatives for private dining. The pool seems part of the river itself, a secluded deck provides respite and beauty treatments are available in the Wellness Centre. For the energetic the gymnasium, running track on the secure property and all-weather tennis court are perfect. Ten luxury en-suite chalets are screened, air-conditioned and have uninterrupted views of the Zambezi.



Activities (on an inclusive rate) include a Victoria Falls Tour, sundowner cruises, tiger fishing, and visiting Simonga Village. Others (extra cost) include white water rafting, bungee jumping, abseiling, canoeing, elephant back safaris and helicopter flights over the Falls. Hippo and elephant are seen regularly and bird life is prolific.
