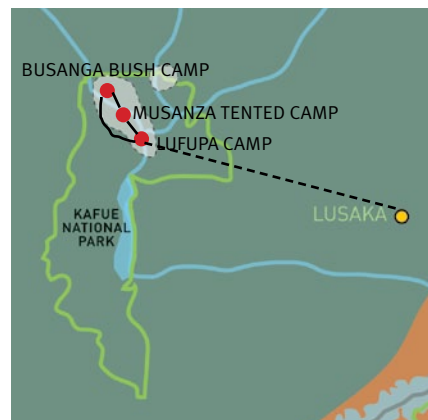


KAFUE'S RIVERS AND PLAINS

ZAMBIA

A Discoverer Exploration - Seven nights/Eight days



Explore the two major arteries of the Kafue National Park: The Kafue and Lufupa Rivers. Traversing the course of the Lufupa River from its confluence with the Kafue, its mix of water from two different catchments clearly apparent, right up to the Busanga Plains takes one through the diverse habitats of riverine forest, miombo woodland, acacia- and palm-strewn floodplain, dambos and ultimately the plains themselves. This mix of habitats harbours a huge diversity of species from leopard and wild dog of the Lufupa woodlands to lion and cheetah of the Busanga Plains, Defassa waterbuck and yellow baboons of the riverine to lechwe and oribi of the grasslands.

BRIEF ITINERARY:

Days 1 & 2: Air charter from Lusaka to Lufupa Tented Camp, Lufupa and Kafue River confluence, northern Kafue National Park

Days 3 & 4: Drive to Musanza Tented Camp, Busanga Plains, north-western Kafue

Days 5 & 6: Drive to Busanga Bush Camp, Central Busanga Plains, Kafue

Day 7: Drive to Lufupa Tented Camp, Kafue

Day 8: Air charter from Lufupa to Lusaka

Note: For guests wishing to begin or end this journey at Livingstone, Victoria Falls, there is no charge for a pick-up/drop-off (at scheduled times), making for a perfect well-priced wildlife safari.
