

## NAMIBIA

A Discoverer Exploration - Nine nights/Ten days



Meet the Namib: the oldest desert in the world; Damaraland: where the largest free-roaming population of black rhino resides; Cape Cross: a bewildering cacophony of Cape fur seals; Etosha: blinding whiteness home to a surprising variety of wildlife. This all-encompassing Exploration explores the spirit of Namibia's most special wild places, its people and culture. Exposed and diverse landscapes, desert wildlife, scenic, jagged mountains, endless skies, and so-called 'barren' deserts all reveal a multitude and variety of life. Accommodation is varied, and the impressive range of activities, whether by day or night, sea or land, by air or vehicle – as well as meeting local Damara and Himba people (dependent on their movements) – reveal the encompassing beauty of this wide-open land.

### BRIEF ITINERARY:

**Days 1 & 2:** Fly to Andersson's Camp, Ongava Game Reserve, Etosha

**Day 3:** Drive to Palmwag Lodge, Palmwag

**Days 4 & 5:** Nature drive to Hoanib Camp, Kaokoland

**Day 6:** Transfer via Twyfelfontein to Damaraland Camp, Damaraland

**Day 7:** Road transfer via Cape Cross seal colony to The Stiltz Lodge, Swakopmund

**Days 8 & 9:** Drive to Walvis Bay for sea kayaking and then to Kulala Wilderness Camp, Sossusvlei

**Day 10:** Drive to Windhoek
